Exam skills resources 	<p>What else can I do to improve?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Go over work covered in class. You should be consistently revising throughout the year – not just right before assessments! Catch up if you are absent and make sure you understand what you missed. Remember to ask your teachers for help. Attend supported study sessions. Practice past papers – with notes, without notes and planning answers. Hand in answers for marking – feedback will help you to improve. Create mind maps or revision pages of entire topics. Keep up to date with RMPS in the news.
