<ul style="list-style-type: none"> What resources do I need? Resources from lessons Teams) Your child has a class Teams page. Each Teams has a general page with a files section. The Files are named according to different aspects of the course such as Expressive Folio, Design folio, Written work, example folios etc. Resources used for the course are available here. How does my child know what their next steps in learning are? Each child has their own Private Channel. This is where they upload their folio work and where their learning conversations take place with their teacher. Individual feedback is given on a regular basis with next steps in learning. My child lacks confidence and doesn't like asking for help, is there a way they can communicate with their teacher, without being in class? How is the course Assessed? Students choose to do either a Design or an Expressive Folio & related contextual analysis:		
EXPRESSIVE	Folio 64 marks Evaluation 6 marks	Folio is externally assessed by SQA. Candidates must complete their evaluation on the SQA template and attach it to the first sheet of the portfolio. There is no word count, but candidates must not exceed the space given on the template (approximately 400 words)
DESIGN	Folio 64 marks Evaluation 6 marks	Folio is externally assessed by SQA. Candidates must complete their evaluation on the SQA template and attach it to the first sheet of the portfolio. There is no word count, but candidates must not exceed the space given on the template (approximately 400 words)
CONTEXTUAL ANALYSIS	30 marks	Worth of the final Mark, externally assessed by SQA. The contextual analysis has a maximum of 2,000 words. If the word count exceeds the maximum by more than 10%, a penalty is applied.

Regularly check your private channel for next steps based on your learning conversations and ensure you complete these. Keep up-to-date with deadlines. Students have a Timeline posted on their general Teams page this can be referred to at any point. It includes review dates, drafts of written work and Folio submission deadlines. Use your additional folio blocks well by attending the art department to continue your work.
