<p>What resources do I need? Resources from lessons Teams)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Your child has a class Teams page. Each Teams has a general page with a files section. The Files are named according to different aspects of the course such as Expressive Folio, Design folio, Written work etc. Resources used for the course are available here. How does my child know what their next steps in learning are? Each child has their own Private Channel. This is where they upload their folio work and where their learning conversations take place with their teacher. Individual feedback is given on a regular basis with next steps in learning. My child lacks confidence and doesn't like asking for help, is there a way they can communicate with their teacher, without being in class? If your child is unsure about anything or are worried about meeting a deadline, they can message their teacher privately on their private Teams. 	<p>What apps and websites can I use to support my learning? <p>Design Folio- 100 marks</p>	<p>Worth 38.5% of the final mark, externally assessed by SQA</p>
<p>Written Exam- 60 marks</p>	<p>2 hour exam-Worth 23% of the final Mark, externally assessed by SQA</p>

Understanding Standards section on the SQA website allows you to search the subject and level you are studying. There you will see visual examples of course work so that you can see what different levels look like within a level. Such as an A Expressive folio at Nat 5 level Art. <p>Where do I find the past papers?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> You will find past papers back to 2018 on the SQA site. For model answers download copies of the marking instructions for each past paper. They are next to the past papers on the SQA website. These show examples of candidate responses so that they can see how marks are awarded. Students have a Timeline posted on their general Teams page this can be referred to at any point. It includes review dates, drafts of written work and Folio submission deadlines. Give yourself lots of time to prepare for the written exam and ensure that your Expressive & Design templates are completed to allow you to revise from these.
